#### **Guidelines**

- To be eligible for the Hampton Chapter of The Links, Incorporated Scholarship (\$1500.00), applicants must meet all of the requirements set forth below.
- Incomplete or late applications *will not* be considered for evaluation.
- Must be a Virginia resident and must demonstrate financial need.
- Indicate whether you are currently enrolled at either Hampton University or Norfolk State University and have been offered greater than 50% of the cost of tuition in financial aid. (Note that college enrollment with such an award of financial aid will not disqualify applicants from consideration.)
- Scholarships awarded under this program will be issued upon receipt of satisfactory verification of enrollment at Hampton University or Norfolk State University.

#### Requirements

- One official college transcript (in a sealed envelope).
- Minimum 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) as shown on an official transcript.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (in sealed envelopes). Letters may be written by a Professor, Community Leader, Employer, etc. *Letters of recommendation may not be from family members.*
- Completed application form typed or clearly printed in blue or black ink.
- The completed application and supporting materials requested must be submitted in one packet and postmarked by **January 15, 2022.**
